#### **An Introduction to the AMSP**

The Advanced Mathematics Support Programme succeeded the FMSP on May 1<sup>st</sup> 2018. This session will outline the broader aims of the AMSP and the increased support that it will offer to teachers and to students studying level 3 mathematics including Core Maths. We will also discuss the advanced maths premium and how it can benefit schools in enhancing their provision.

#### **Better equipping your post 16 students to the mathematical demands of their future: Core Maths**

This session will look at why you would offer Core Maths and what it could look like in your centre. It will outline the support for centres, teachers and students that is already in place and what is in the pipeline for the future. You will also have an opportunity to look at the mathematical content of the qualification and to engage with some of the resources designed especially for Core Maths.

**Paul** is a member of the AMSP Central Team where he is responsible for organizing online tuition for students studying Further Mathematics A Level. He also leads the Teaching Statistics Course and delivers other PD such as the use of technology. Prior to working for the AMSP and the FMSP, Paul taught mathematics for 26 years in both the UK and overseas.

**Tom** is the Deputy Lead for the Central Maths Hub where he is responsible for the Secondary Mastery Lead Programme and post 16 work groups. He is the lead on the Core Maths work group having been a lead for the Core Maths Support Programme for the three preceding years. Tom however, is still a classroom teacher and in his fourth year of delivering Core Maths.

The West Midlands Mathematics Teacher Network is an FMSP-funded project allowing teachers of maths to meet, to collaborate and to share professional development. We usually meet termly and the programme is a mixture of informal sessions and speaker-led training events.
